The President's Report 2024

Seniors and Reserve grade premierships in our centenary year! What a great highlight to complete the season, and showcase our club achievement of being the first AFL club in South East Queensland to reach 100 years! A fitting way to reward our players, coaches, supporters, sponsors and committee members for their dedication, passion and effort on this journey.

Along with the premierships, other significant events of our centenary season featured our Hall of Fame night in which over 400 Mayne faithful attended and around 160 past and present members were inducted into the inaugural club Hall of Fame. The night was an outstanding success as Tigers from all generations gathered to recognise contributions from individuals who have built the club into the success that it is today.

Coinciding with the Hall of Fame was our annual Mick Nolan Reunion Day which featured all of our tiger teams playing on Sunday May 26th in celebration of our 100th season. Making the day even more special was the attendance of past players celebrating the 10th anniversary of the drought breaking 2014 premierships.

The club's historians combined to release an updated version of the club's official history by releasing an anthology covering the last 10 years titled "Feel the Roar". The book is a companion to the club's first book titled "From Glory to Heartache" which chronicled the first 90 years of the club.

Mayne Past Players and Supporters Group led by Dick Fell, Rod Judd and Graham McColm produced a highly impressive mural of the club's history that has been installed in the clubhouse which showcases the people and events that make our club so great.

The improvement to the match day facilities at our home ground at Mott Street continued with the relaying of turf on the playing surface on both ovals and the installation of the timekeeper and medical shed. Huge thanks to John Laing and Graeme "Wally" Wallace for their work on these projects.

The club overall is in a great position, providing opportunities for football for all, with continued growth and participation of our Women's team and the popularity of our more social or recreational offering the Thirds side that play on Friday nights.

Financially the club is in a very sound position, however we are anticipating a very modest trading deficit for this season due to the additional expenses of the construction of the timekeepers shed and ground keeping costs.

Third Grade Coach's Report 2024
