Tigers in strong showing against reigning Premiers



Club Captain Zac McLean led the way for the Tigers against the Springwood Pumas at the Den yesterday.

It was the first hitout of the season yesterday for the Tigers as they took on reigning premiers the Springwood Pumas in an extended practice match at the Den over six quarters. The senior group played the first four quarters while the Reserves finished the day with two quarters.

The Pumas still look the full package that took them to their giant killing grand final performance against the Kings last year. Rowan Paige was once again as dangerous as ever while former Mayne Tiger Jake Warren impressed with his reading of the play, hard running and precise skills. In addition to being a great talent, he is a quality person as well.

The game opened up in the second term with both sides able to show their attacking prowess. Club Captain Zac McLean was in good form to start his campaign as he accumulated possessions around the ground while five time Club Champion Jack Collings just keeps on doing what he does best winning the hard ball and getting the Tigers going forward under all manner of pressure.
