on the Red Lions right from the first bounce to dominate the opening term. The Tigers had first use of the ball with ruckman Matthew Storey using his considerable size to best advantage while Zac Puncken swooped on every chance for a centre clearance.

The Tigers tall forwards of Jack Gartlan and Chris Fletcher were on the end of some impressive entries while the mosquito fleet of Declan Goodwin and Xavier Craven were running amok.

All of this was made more impressive with the Tigers kicking into the teeth of a strong north easterly breeze.

While the Tigers were dominating field position and possession, they unfortunately could not kick away to a game winning lead with the wind playing havoc

with accuracy. The Tigers finished the guarter with two goals and five behinds but impressively held the Red Lions to a solitary point even though they had the wind advantage.

The Tigers midfield rotations were providing them with plenty of options with several of their group having had the opportunity to play in the higher grade over recent weeks. Josh Geurts and Nick Galvin were particularly dangerous and hard working all day.

In typical fashion the Red Lions reverted to their default style with the second guarter dominated by one on one defence and persistent stoppages. The Tigers had the wind but the quarter was played almost exclusively on the dead side of the ground with an extraordinary number of ball ups and throw ins. The size of Lowe Oval also contributed to the crowded play with limited opportunities to open the game up.

While the Tigers were stymied in the second term to continue their earlier dominance the Red Lions were unable to breach the Tigers defence to any degree with Stew Settle, Tim Lyons and Andy Tydink at their intercepting best.

The Tigers came out after the main break determined to get the scoreboard ticking over and while the Red Lions kicked the first goal, the Tigers turned it on for a withering five minute three goal burst once again starting from three impressive
